- Oversees special projects
- Serving as the point person for all hotlines and constituent complaints.
- Providing oversight and coordination of internal investigations, supervisory reviews, and root cause analysis then developing and deploying all action steps for any necessary remediation.
- Sharing on-call responsibilities.
