



REGISTERED NURSE

The Nurse at Niles Home for Children is responsible for conducting assessments on all residential children as well as providing nursing assessment and consultations to our Niles Prep Students. The Nurse also works closely with our Psychiatrist for both Residential and Niles Prep in ordering medications, setting appointments for lab and other health appointments. The Nurse is part of the Multi-disciplinary Team and attends weekly staffing and provides nursing assessment information to designated and approved outside providers. The Nurse also provides Clinical oversight to the Residential Medication Level I Techs who dispense medication and reviews and gives feedback on the MARS and issues related to Medication Management.

Qualifications:

- BSN with 2-3 years of nursing experience in the field of Psych and or adolescent medicine in pediatric/adolescent psychiatry, or public health and school based nursing.
- Knowledge of pediatric/adolescent psychotropic medications and the affects.
- Understand and respond to compliance and accreditation issues.
- Ability to define wellness, and health promotion through the application of standards of community health and population health.
- Knowledgeable of Medicaid guidelines and third party payers (insurers).
- Ability to perform health assessment and devise plan of care to include health management, disease prevention, nutrition and physical and recreational fitness.
- Ability to do discharge planning.
